We have had a lovely week in Acorns learning all about the change in season. We have been talking about how Winter brings about changes in weather, what we wear and what happens to the trees and animals. The children have also been creating some wonderful Christmas crafts which they will bring home at the end of the term. As well as working hard during our Christmas performances to sing and recite our poems. In math this week we have been continuing to learn about repeated patterns using different coloured resources and natural objects. To support your child at home perhaps you could create pasta patterns. Using different types of pasta, children can create a pattern, or necklace if using the types with a hole through. As part of our phonics learning we have continued sharing rhyming stories and seeing if the children can hear and notice the rhyming words. We have also been supporting the children in their play to notice and comment on the initial sounds of different objects and finding objects that start with the same sound.

Blast off!



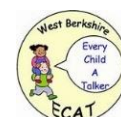
Well done to Zac who is our Acorn of the week and gets to take home our class bear 'Mr. Snuggles' this week!
